Giving Approach

What is a Charity Fund?

An AusGiving Charity Fund supports an eligible Australian charity that is registered with the ACNC, endorsed as an Item 1 DGR, and undertaking activities consistent with AusGiving's benevolent purposes.

The Charity Fund provides a structured way for Australian donors to support your charity through AusGiving's governance and administrative framework, including the receipt, tracking, and distribution of donations.

Purpose-built for Australia, the AusGiving Charity Fund helps eligible Australian charities receive support from Australian donors through AusGiving's local giving pathway. All distributions remain subject to AusGiving's review, approval, and oversight.

A simple way for Australian donors to support your mission

With an AusGiving Charity Fund, eligible Australian charities can receive support from Australian donors through AusGiving's structured local giving pathway. AusGiving handles donor receipting, administration, grant processing, and compliance checks, helping reduce the administrative burden for your team.

- ✓ Receive regular Charity Fund statements and updates by email
- ✓ Reduce administration through AusGiving's donor receipting and grant-processing support.
- ✓ Support donor anonymity or donor-stated purposes where applicable.

International Giving Through TrustBridge

Australian charities that want to receive grants from international donors may also apply to establish a corresponding TrustBridge Charity Fund. This is separate from the AusGiving Charity Fund and is governed by TrustBridge's own terms, onboarding, due diligence, and applicable assessments.

Where a TrustBridge Charity Fund is established, the charity may access GivingSpace and may be eligible to receive grants from international donors through TrustBridge or other TrustBridge Network Members.
